4. Give me five dinner ideas using chicken, broccoli, and rice.
5. What are three creative ways AI could save me one hour every week?

Claude

Best at: Long documents, writing, thoughtful analysis

1. Summarize this document into one page. *(Paste a long article.)*
2. Improve this resume for a leadership position.
3. Compare the strengths and weaknesses of remote work.
4. Review this policy and identify unclear language.
5. Write a motivational speech for volunteers.

Microsoft Copilot

Best at: Microsoft 365, Office, productivity

1. Create an agenda for a one-hour staff meeting.
2. Turn these meeting notes into action items.
3. Build an Excel formula to calculate monthly expenses.
4. Draft a professional follow-up email after a job interview.
5. Create a PowerPoint outline about AI in education.

Gemini

Best at: Google Workspace, research, multimodal tasks

1. Create a two-day itinerary for Boston using free attractions.
2. Explain climate change using simple language and examples.
3. Organize these brainstorming ideas into categories.
4. Create a study guide for a biology exam.
5. Compare three smartphones under \$600.

Prompt Challenge 1 – Explain Something Complex

- **You are an award-winning middle school science teacher.**
- Explain how artificial intelligence works to an 11-year-old.
- Use a sports analogy, avoid technical jargon, keep it under 300 words, and end with three quiz questions to check understanding.

Compare

- Which AI uses the best analogy?
- Which is easiest to understand?

Prompt Challenge 2 – Professional Writing

Act as an executive communications coach.

Rewrite the email below so it sounds warm, confident, and professional.

- Keep it under 150 words.
- Remove unnecessary words.
- Preserve all important information.
- Then explain the three biggest improvements you made.
- (Paste an actual email.)

Compare

- Writing quality
- Explanation of edits
- Tone

Prompt Challenge 3 – Planning

- You are an experienced travel planner.
- Plan a four-day family vacation to Boston for two adults and one child (age 8).
- Budget: \$1,500.

Include:

- Daily itinerary
- Estimated costs

- Family-friendly restaurants
